294 At that day - You Shall Know

John 14:20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. Pretty well most Christians believe that when we are born again, our body becomes the temple of the Holy Spirit. (1Co 6:19). BUT thats all they believe, they don't take the time nor the effort to search the scriptures and let the Holy Spirit teach them. (1Jo 2:27) It is much easier to here somebody from behind a pulpit, or read some mans commendatory, instead of verifying what you heard and read, against what the Holy Spirit taught you. What comes from the pulpit or a commentary may be right, but unfortunetly not. WHY DO YOU THINK we have so many denominations compared to true Deciples? Just because you have attended a bible school or seminary, it does not mean it is what the Holy Spirit wants you to learn.

John 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me....

1John 5:9 If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.

Jesus had no problem saying, "I and the father are one", but for us to say that Jesus and I are one, is sacrilegious. Yet we believe that we are the temple of the Holy Ghost and we also believe Jesus when he said;

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. Jesus did nothing in his own power, but through the Holy Spirit that was within and upon him, so, we can do nothing on our own but through the Holy Spirit.

The sad part about the majority of Christians today, is that they only believe a little bit of the teachings of the fullness of his ministry. "That is like being just a little bit pregnant" You either ARE or YOUR NOT.

This is like believing the word of God! You either believe it ALL or NOT AT ALL. Do you honestly think that when Jesus asks, **DO YOU BELIEV**E, that he is going to change his judgements just because you say, I believe SOME of it BUT NOT ALL. Now I am no way saying that if you no not believe the full ministry of the Holy Spirit that you will not go to heaven, because the bible says: **Romans 10:13** For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

But you not only MISS a lot of victories and peace in this present life, but you will miss out on a lot of the rewards that are given out in heaven.

If you don't believe me, just ask someone that did not believe in tithing to the Lord, THEN they were enlightened

Haggi 1:6 Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes.

then started tithing. We went from always being short to ALWAYS having some left over.

You ask anybody that didn't believe in tithing, and then the Lord opened their understanding and they started to give their first fruits to the Lord or to where he directs you (not man) and they started giving 10% and have increased to 90%. They will all say that the Lords share comes first, automatically, and they always have ample left. I have shared this to open your understanding to the importance of believing Gods word. When he said, you shall receive power AFTER that the Holy Spirit is come UPON you,

(Acts 1:8) he means what he said. Once you realize that you are 1/3 Holy Ghost and the word of God is true then **John 14:20** At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.
