

Mr 16:16* He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Notice it **DOES NOT SAY** (after the semicolon), it does however, say if you believe not (thats in Jesus) you will be dammed. Be saved; but **he that believeth not** and is not baptized shall be damned.

That scripture bothered me a lot, because the scripture tells of the thief on the cross, where Jesus said, "this day, you will be with me in paradise". I ask the Lord, If you are supposed to be baptized in water after you believe, the thief wasn't, did you make an exception. He said of course not, the gospel is the same for ALL. He that believeth and is baptized, **IS A STATEMENT and NOT A LAW**. Yet how many God fearing people do not believe it. They preach, BY GRACE ARE YOU SAVED, but then they SAY you HAVE TO BE BAPTIZED in water. If you believe this, this part is works and works will not and cannot EVER save you.

First of all I want to point out, the scripture teaches that scripture is spiritually deserned and cannot be understood according to the natural mind, 1Corinthians 2: 9,16 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of **God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.**

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, **but which the Holy Ghost teacheth;** comparing spiritual things with spiritual?

But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

And again in 1John 2:27* But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

The Lord says that his sheep (us) know his voice.

John 10:27 but so many religious people are afraid that it might be the Devil. TO THIS I SAY, **who are you serving?**

There are many things the bible teaches, which is not written in exact wording, **SO MAN WILL NOT BELIEVE**, but if we ask the Lord, HE WILL tell us or show us. **James 1:5*** If any of you **lack wisdom**, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

There are also many, many things that are written letter by letter, **AND THEY WILL STILL NOT BELIEVE THE TRUTH.**

I'll point out just a few:

They teach Jesus was about 2 years old when they left Bethlehem. NOT TRUE; he was 40 days old when they went back to Nazareth, and not Egypt like the Denominations teach. Luke 2.22 was 40 days after Jesus birth, Mary had to offer sacrifices according to the law, so the left, and verse 2.39 says they went back to Nazareth from there.

THE THREE MAGI didn't show up in Jerusalem until Jesus was about a year to a year and a half old as Herod wasn't sure so he killed all male kids from newborn to just to be sure he got Jesus. Another mistake he made was he figured the Magi went to Bethlehem. Not so, when the Magi left Herod Matthew 2.10 says the star appeared and they followed it, it doesn't say Nazareth but if you have read Luke then you know it was Nazareth.

THIS IS WHEN THE ANGEL APPEARED TO JOSEPH TO GO TO EGYPT, they now could afford it, due to the gifts of the Magi.

ANOTHER MYTH: is EASTER. Jesus said in **Mt 12:40***.

Three days and three nights he would be in the centre of the earth. The religious order changed that to one day and depending on how you look at it, 2 nights at the most. How many denominations preach the truth? You Say, whats the big deal? Well, if you can bel that easily led down the garden path by YOUR TRADITIONS, how much more when you got Satan whispering in your ear, Thats another thing that never ceases to amaze me, most professing Christians have no problem hearing Satans voice.

Just remember, that the lord wants you to understand his voice, because he created you for fellowship. Which one of you's that have a spouse or close friend and never hear or speak to them.
