

389 Are there two Gospels?

NO, not according to the bible. [Philippians 1:27](#). Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in **one spirit**, with **one mind** striving together for the faith of the **gospel**;

BUT according to the many different religious Leaders, they make up what ever suits them.

Man is a creature of **HABIT** and why do you think Jesus warned us to be aware of the tradition of man.

[Colossians 2:8](#) Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

When you have been doing something a certain way for a few 1000 years (the law), It would not be easy to switch to **GRACE**.

FIRST of all, the first dispensation was, the law the Law was not done away with, rather Jesus fulfilled the **LAW**.

SECOND dispensation is **GRACE**, [Ephesians 2:8](#) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

The hardest factor in the first church age was to totally accept the disciples rendition of Christ and the Gospel, and the carnally minded, still don't grasp it.

The biggest factor that Satan uses to hoodwink people, is the Sabbath day. **JESUS** was man, here on earth and was limited or he couldn't of fulfilled being our redeemer. When Jesus said keep my commandments, the average person, automatically thinks of the ten commandments.

This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

[John 13:34](#) A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

Then in Pauls writing, God said [Colossians 2:16](#) **Let no man therefore judge** you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of **the** new moon, or of **the** sabbath days:

When Paul went to Jerusalem to dispute the law laid upon the Gentiles, the Apostle led by the Holy Spirit to the **CHURCH**

[Acts 15:22\29](#) Then pleased it the apostles and elders with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas and Silas, chief men among the brethren: And they wrote letters by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and brethren send greeting unto the brethren which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia. Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment: It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul, Men that have hazarded their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We have sent therefore Judas and Silas, who shall also tell you the same things by mouth. For it seemed good to the Holy

Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.

Satan has been telling the believers in Jesus, it is OK to believe Jesus **BUT** you have to do this or that. Anyway you slice it, if you feel you **HAVE TO DO** something, it's **WORKS or LAW.**

Grace is what God gives you and you do not deserve it, and you use **FAITH** to obtain the things Jesus already paid the price for.
